We're constantly reviewing our provision for children and young people. In a changing world, it's important to make sure their access to Jesus is as comfortable, relevant and straight forward as possible.

To make things more familiar to surroundings in school and to be sympathetic to other changes in their lives, we're shifting to three new groups on Sunday mornings:



GROUP: EARLY YEARS

AGE: FROM BIRTH TO RECEPTION WHERE: CURRENT CRECHE ROOM



GROUP: KIDS

AGE: YEAR 1 TO YEAR 5

WHERE: KIDS ROOM (UPSTAIRS IN THE HALL)



GROUP: YOUTH

AGE: YEAR 6+

WHERE: YOUTH ROOM (UPSTAIRS IN THE HALL)

We're also adding an extra week of kids provision on the 4th Sunday of each month!

1st Sunday - no groups (Messy Church in May, Jul, Oct & Dec!)
2nd Sunday - all groups running
3rd Sunday - Early Years as normal, Youth and Kids worship in the hall
4th Sunday - all groups running

We know change can be hard to navigate, so for anyone with children in Reception or Year 5, please feel free to talk to your child/young person and choose together which group best suits them until September, at which point they'll slot into the designated group for their school year.


Parish Update Eapem

We are asking, where possible, for nominations to be submitted to Rod or to the church office in advance of the meeting, to maximise efficiency on the day.




The agenda and annual report will be circulated by email shortly, with hard copies available for anyone not on email.
